

THINGS YOU CAN DO FOR FUN!

1. Using a map or globe, try to find 5 countries that start with “A”; 5 that start with “B”; 5 that start with “C” and so on.
2. Cut out pictures from a magazine of things you like- use a hole punch and pipe cleaners and make a “favorite things” mobile.
3. Do a sticker activity book. Or make your own!
4. Practice letters with a wipe off marker on a laminated surface.
5. Pretend to be a doctor/dentist/repair man with a doctor kit/tool kit – create a waiting room and office.
6. Play outside – make a fort or hide out.
7. Use play foam or play clay to make a dinosaur family.
8. Do a word search, maze, or connect the dots (use online printables).
9. Using matchbox cars and masking tape create a parking lot sorted by color, model or favorites.
10. Draw a picture or make a card for someone.
11. Cook something using a microwave recipe.
12. Use sidewalk chalk to make a hopscotch board.
13. Use dollhouse or action figures to act out a scene from your day at school.
14. Practice gymnastic moves, somersaults, straddles, bridges, etc.
15. Create music with instruments – put on a concert!
16. Use puppets to make up a puppet show, practice it and put on a show for the family.
17. Think of a story, have an adult type it up, print it out and then illustrate pictures to go with it.
18. Make a hide-away spot – a closet is a great place!
19. Use glue and craft sticks to create a fort/building/or whatever you can imagine.
20. Create a pretend restaurant complete with menu, servers and a decorative table setting.
21. Look at a photo album.
22. Do a science experiment.
23. Make a quiz with index cards for Mom or Dad with info you are studying in school.
24. Make a list of things you want to do or places you want to go in the future.
25. Ride a bike – create an obstacle course in the yard.
26. Practice your aim – try to throw a ball into a bucket. Move it further and further away.
27. Make a booklet all about your favorites.
28. Plan a play date with a friend – make the invitation, come up with a schedule, etc.
