GOALS

The purpose of this parenting tool is to help your child:


- 1) ACCEPT responsibility for his or her behavior.
- 2) IDENTIFY what he or she did wrong.
- 3) CONNECT inward heart attitude to behavior.
- 4) UNDERSTAND God's will for him or her.




METHOD


- 1) Provide many opportunities during the day for your child to learn about God's love, power and forgiveness when misbehavior is not an issue.
- 2) If a misbehavior occurs, provide an appropriate consequence.
- 3) After the consequence, when your child is calm, lay the cards out in front of him or her.
- 4) Use the following questions and statements as a guide: "What did you do wrong?" "Pick the card that shows that best." "Why do you think that was wrong?" "Let's see what you could do instead." (reverse card) "God has something to say about this. Let's read what it is." "What we have in our hearts, shows in how we act."
- 5) Add the salvation message: "We all make mistakes but there is hope because God loves us and will forgive us." Seek and offer forgiveness. Remind your child that sorry is shown by what he does and not just by what he says.
- 6) Pray with your child over the specific area that was problematic. Hug him or her
- 7) End by helping your child find a concrete way to make ammends for the misbehavior.


